



## VOTE EARLY

☆ **EARLY VOTING begins Monday, September 22, 2008** and ends Friday, October 24, 2008. During this time, registered Georgia voters may cast their ballot in person, on weekdays, at the office of their county registrar. Find the location and hours of your registrar at the Georgia Secretary of State's website at [www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter](http://www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter) or by calling (888) 265-1115.

☆ **ADVANCE VOTING WEEK begins Monday, October 27, 2008** and ends Friday, October 31, 2008. Registered Georgia voters may cast their ballot in person during Advance Voting week at any Advance Voting center in their county. Most counties will have multiple voting centers set up during this week, many with extended hours. Find the location and hours of your Advance Voting center(s) at the Georgia Secretary of State's website at [www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter](http://www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter) or by calling (888) 265-1115.

No reason is needed to Vote Early or Vote in Advance, but photo ID is required. For Voter ID requirements visit [www.gaphotoid.com](http://www.gaphotoid.com) or call toll free (877) 725-9797.

## VOTE ABSENTEE

If one is not attached to this flyer, you may download an official Absentee Ballot Request form from the Georgia Secretary of State's website at [www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter](http://www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter)

Print and return the completed form to your county registrar by fax or mail. Find the address and fax number for your registrar at the Georgia Secretary of State's website at [www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter](http://www.sos.georgia.gov/electioncenter) or by calling (888) 265-1115.

No reason is required to request an Absentee Ballot. If you are physically disabled or living temporarily outside your county of residence, a close relative may apply for an Absentee Ballot for you. **Photo ID is not required when voting Absentee by mail.**

Once you receive your Absentee Ballot in the mail, simply fill it out (remember to sign), and mail it back. Completed Absentee Ballots must be received by your County Board of registrars' office by Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2008. To make sure you receive your Absentee Ballot in time, please submit your Absentee Ballot Request no later than Tuesday, October 21, 2008.

### VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

If you do not Vote Early, Vote in Advance or vote by Absentee Ballot, you may vote on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2008. Polls will be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Election Day. If you are in line to vote by 7:00pm, you must be allowed to vote.
